- On the 7th of June we visited two social centres in Mislata and actively participated in discussing different problems and things young people have to deal with every day.



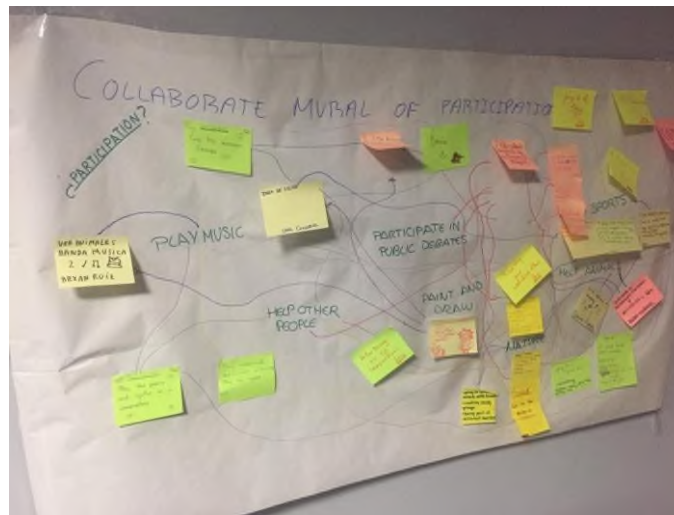
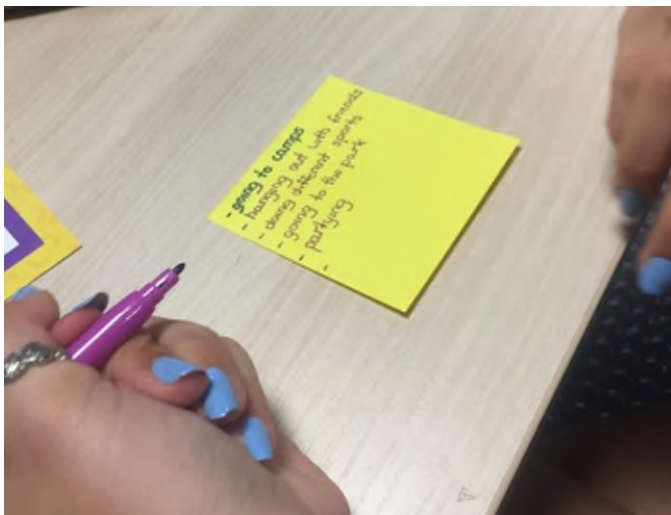
Tuesday

Wednesday

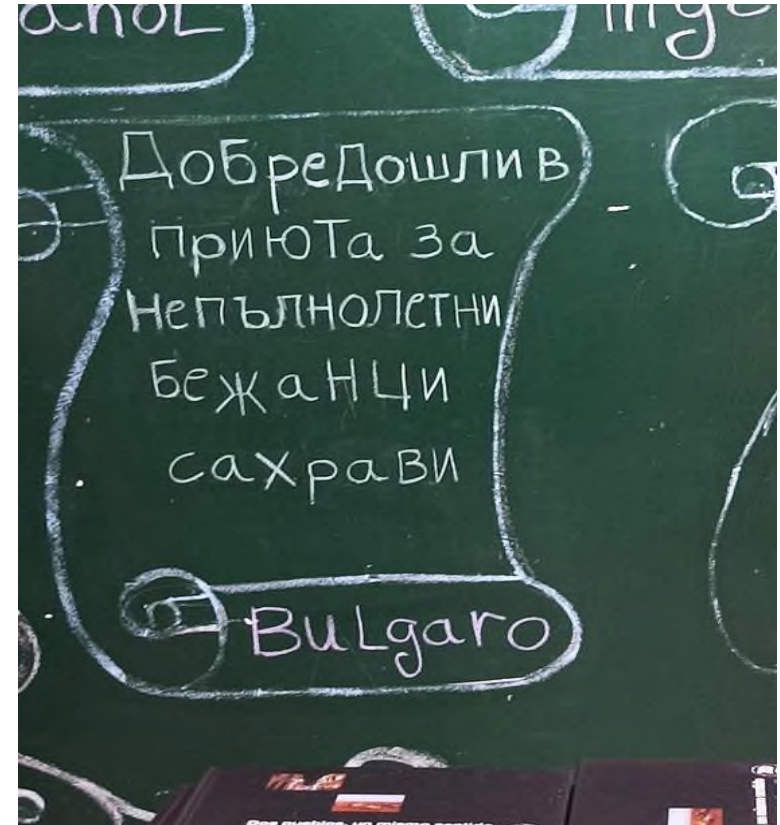


- After those activities we went to Biopark Valencia where we had an amazing experience seeing all animals in almost their natural habitat.
